

## Course Requirements for MA Program:

The Integrated MA program requires 60 credit hours of course work, including a 6 hours' thesis related to the student's ministry. The program normally shall require two years of course work and six months of writing the thesis, at least two and half years to complete the course.

The Course of MA is six months in length, but include only four weeks (two weeks in summer and two weeks in winter) residence class. 1st and the rest semesters shall be at CCGU Main Campus, Kanglatongbi, Manipur, India for non-Korean students and the 3rd Semester shall be at TGU, South Korea. Korean students will also have a Module of two-week at CCGU Campus, Kanglatongbi, Manipur, India. There will also be Online Class for all the students once in a week, a total number of 24 classes in a semester. During the non-resident months, students are to read and interact with the course materials. After the course, students meet for the resident week, after which students complete all the assignments for the course. The on-going students' registration for summer course must be completed by April 15 and winter course by September 15.

## Integrated MA Program Course Design

The MA degree is a combine Integrated Program of **Trinity Global University and Chil Chil Global University**. It is designed for those who are either retired or working but interested to learn God's Word and get involve in a full-time Ministry.

The program is in ministry rather than in residence allowing the students to remain in their current ministry/office, incorporating their studies directly and immediately. Students complete relevant reading and writing assignments before and after a two-week resident portion. The two weeks' resident portion of the course normally shall occur in **January and June**.

## Resident Period

All Students are required to stay 2 weeks and earn 6 credit hours per semester. Whereas teachers from abroad are required to stay only 1 week to teach a subject. Therefore, 2 teachers will be engaged to teach 2 subjects for every semester.

5. Room & Board for 2 Weeks	Rs. 6,000.00	(Per Sem)



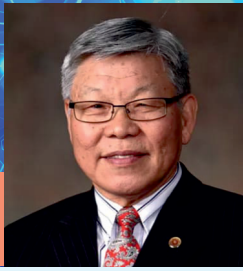
# INTEGRATED MASTER OF ARTS PROGRAM

## Purpose of the Integrated MA Program

The integrated MA degree program is designed to provide advanced training in the practice of biblically and theologically oriented ministry with a mission focus to those actively involved in vocational or bi-vocational ministry and also those who are still under preparation for future ministry.

Students have opportunity to learn from well qualified and distinguished faculty coming into India from U.S.A. and South Korea. The best part of this program is that there is no need to stay on campus the entire time while the students are studying for the MA degree.

The students can remain in their particular Ministry/Office throughout the program and are only required to attend the resident and online classes for the specified dates.

## How does Integrated MA Program Study Work?

Integrated MA Program studies are built on a foundation of biblical theology and ministry theory, but focus on practical and mission related aspect of ministry. While professors bring their expertise to the classroom, significant participation by the students is encouraged and learning is a collaborative process. Enhancing the identified ministerial skills such as preaching, teaching, leadership, administration, counselling, spiritual formation etc. Before and after the resident portion of each course, the student will complete assignments. At the end of the entire MA Program, the student is required to write a Thesis which implements and evaluates the ministry in the student's particular context.

## Prospective Candidate for MA

The Integrated MA Program admits men and women who show evidence that they (1) are born again and possess good Christian character; (2) have an academic record that demonstrates superior ability and shows promises of success in Master degree studies; and (3) holds a Bachelor of Theology (Th.B) or such an equivalent from a recognized college/seminary/university with a B+ grade.

All the Applicants for MA program must submit all the required documents for admission along with Rs. 3,000/- processing fee. Prospective students may apply for admission at any time. The deadline for the admission is April 15. For details on admission please contact the Registrar.

## Divisional and Categorization of Professors and Students

- Four Visiting Professors from outside of the State/Country shall be engaged to teach **Core subjects** at CCGU Campus.
- Online-class' Professors shall be the same for both Korean and Non-Korean students and have together the same subject.
- Korean students shall have their own **Core subjects** arrange by the TGU as per their requirement and suitability.
- There will be a combine class at TGU and CCGU every year for different batch for **exploration and cross-culture program**.
